

## Fees for Providers in the U.S. and Canada

Providers are required to pay an application fee when submitting an application for initial recognition. Once approved, in order to maintain recognition status, all ADA CERP approved providers must submit an annual report, and periodically submit an application for continued recognition. Providers are also assessed an annual fee. No annual fee will be required in the year the provider receives initial CERP recognition.

Annual fees are assessed based on the size of the provider’s overall continuing education program, based on the total number of participant in all CE activities the provider offered the prior year.

**Level 1:** Fewer than 1,000 total participants in all CE activities offered per annum

**Level 2:** 1,000 – 15,000 total participants in all CE activities offered per annum

**Level 3:** More than 15,000 total participants in all CE activities offered per annum

The Commission will view non-payment of all required fees within the established deadline(s) as a decision by the ADA CERP-recognized provider to voluntarily withdraw from ADA CERP. The name of the previously recognized provider will be removed from the current list of ADA CERP recognized providers when it is next published. Any provider wishing to reinstate its recognition following discontinuation for non-payment of fees will be required to submit an ADA CERP Application and follow the established procedures for recognition.

Fees support ADA CERP program operating expenses and are subject to change annually. Fees are non-refundable.
